Session Plan (15 mins)

Do all young people have enough say in their rights?



Timing	Activity	Resources
1-2minutes	Starter Question : Ask students to discuss in pairs whether they think the young people are safe or not, and why. Reveal the images.	PPT slide 2
1 minutes	Reveal the topic, Learning Objectives, Keywords and Issues to discuss : Reveal the topic, LOs, Keywords and Issues To discuss.	PPT slides 3-4
5 minutes	Why are we learning about this? UNICEF campaign. Watch the video and make notes on what parents think is important for children. Introduce the rights of the child. Look at the 4 areas and ask students to list what rights they think they should have under each heading. Reveal the rights.	PPT slides 5-7
5-10 minutes	Are you taken seriously enough? Introduce the understanding that adults have responsibility for children's rights, ask students to carry out the role play to emphasise how this can sometimes be very tricky! As a class discuss whether adults take your views seriously or not, and if not what can be done to change this. Share ideas, you could even consider as a school how you could improve how well students are listened to, or what channels are in place to support their views.

1 minute	Students go online & cast their vote or vote manually	PPT slides 11-12
