STARTING RRSA ONLINE

A digital learning course to guide you towards applying for the first stage of the Award, Bronze: Rights Committed.

Online training is included within the new registration fee for schools who have registered from January 2018.

For schools who have registered before January 2018, a fee of **£200** is applicable for access to multiple users.

Starting RRSA Online can be used for staff CPD.

Each course contains approximately 30 minutes of online material followed by an hour of "homework", where you put your knowledge into action.
