5 minutes	If you were rich As a starting point to this debate ask students how they would budget if they earned £10 million per year. In pairs they should share their ideas. As a class find out how much the students would give to charity.	PPT slide 7
4 minutes	How much do rich people give? On the slide look at some famous people and how much they have given to charity. What do your students think of this?	PPT slide 8
5 minutes	Why are we talking about this? Introduce to students Soccer Aid. Watch the 2 videos, firstly to learn more about soccer aid and who is taking part and secondly the video of Sebenele who has benefitted from the money raised through the soccer aid campaign.	PPT slide 9

1 minute	Really encourage students to reflect on this topic as it is hard hitting, then when they are ready they can vote.	PPT slides 11-12
