Is it important to fit in at school?





			
1 min	Feedback	Whole class	Pupils see the results and feedback from last week's topic.
2-5 mins	1. Starter: Where do I fit in?	Pair activity	In pairs, pupils think about what groups they fit into, and what labels they would use to describe themselves.
3-5 mins	2. Why are we talking about this?	Whole class	Pupils explore why this topic is in the news at the moment.
5-10 mins	3. Just like everybody else?	Whole class	Pupils take a look at some statements and move to show whether it applies to them or not, highlighting how different we all are.
10-15 mins	4. "Fitting the mould"	Whole class	Looking at five scenarios, pupils decide if each one shows bullying, and what they would do in that situation.
5-10 mins	5. Over to you!	Whole class	Pupils read six statements and use their thumbs to show whether they agree or disagree.
3-5 mins	6. I will...	Individual	Pupils make a pledge to help end bullying in their school.
N/A	Career Launchpad!	Whole class	Pupils have the opportunity to take this topic beyond the classroom. See below for details.
N/A	Vote	Whole class	Pupils review the Yes/No arguments for this topic before casting their vote.
