

The conflict in Syria has raged for over five years, placing more than eight million children in terrible danger. It is the largest humanitarian crisis since World War II. Children urgently need food, clean water and health care, as well as life-saving protection from violence and the chance to learn in safety.

Unicef is one of the few agencies working for children inside Syria and in surrounding countries.				
The money raised b	ру			
will help Unicef provide urgent life-saving supplies to children and families affected by the crisis. For example £6 could help pay for life-saving treatment for a child with pneumonia or diarrhoea, £54 could provide two families with an emergency hygiene kit and £100 could provide support for three children who have suffered the psychological trauma of war.				
To make their fundraising go even further, the UK Government will match schools' donations pound for pound, helping Unicef reach even more of Syria's children
