## MEET FARAH.

Six-year-old Farah lives in a refugee camp with her mum, brother and three older sisters.

Next year is a big year: Farah will start attending a Unicef-supported school, and she can't wait. "I am most looking forward to learning," says Farah. "The letters, alphabet, writing."

Farah has lived in the refugee camp for four years. Her family were forced to leave their home in Syria because it was too dangerous to stay. Now her whole family lives in a small caravan.

One in three Syrian children have grown up knowing only crisis. Their childhoods have been filled with fear. Unicef is helping children like Farah go back to school and have safe places to play.
