Pancake Day

It's flippin' fantastic! Hold a **pancake sale** at school for pre-lesson breakfasts or breaktime treats to fundraise for Unicef this month. Ask students to make a donation to purchase theirs and offer colourful toppings too. Why not hold a staffroom sweepstake on who can flip a pancake the most number of times in a minute? £2 per stake - winner keeps half, and half goes to Unicef's work for children - tasty!

Kindness Day

During the February half term, ask students to make **a gesture of kindness to children in danger** by keeping a collection jar at home for family, friends and visitors to contribute any spare change. On their first day back collect and count all donations and use an assembly to celebrate the positive action the school has taken for children.

Valentine's Day

Celebrate the rights you love at school this Valentine's Day and ask students to explore the **United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child**. They can share a two minute presentation on a right that they love, explaining why that particular right is so special and important for children, wherever they are.
