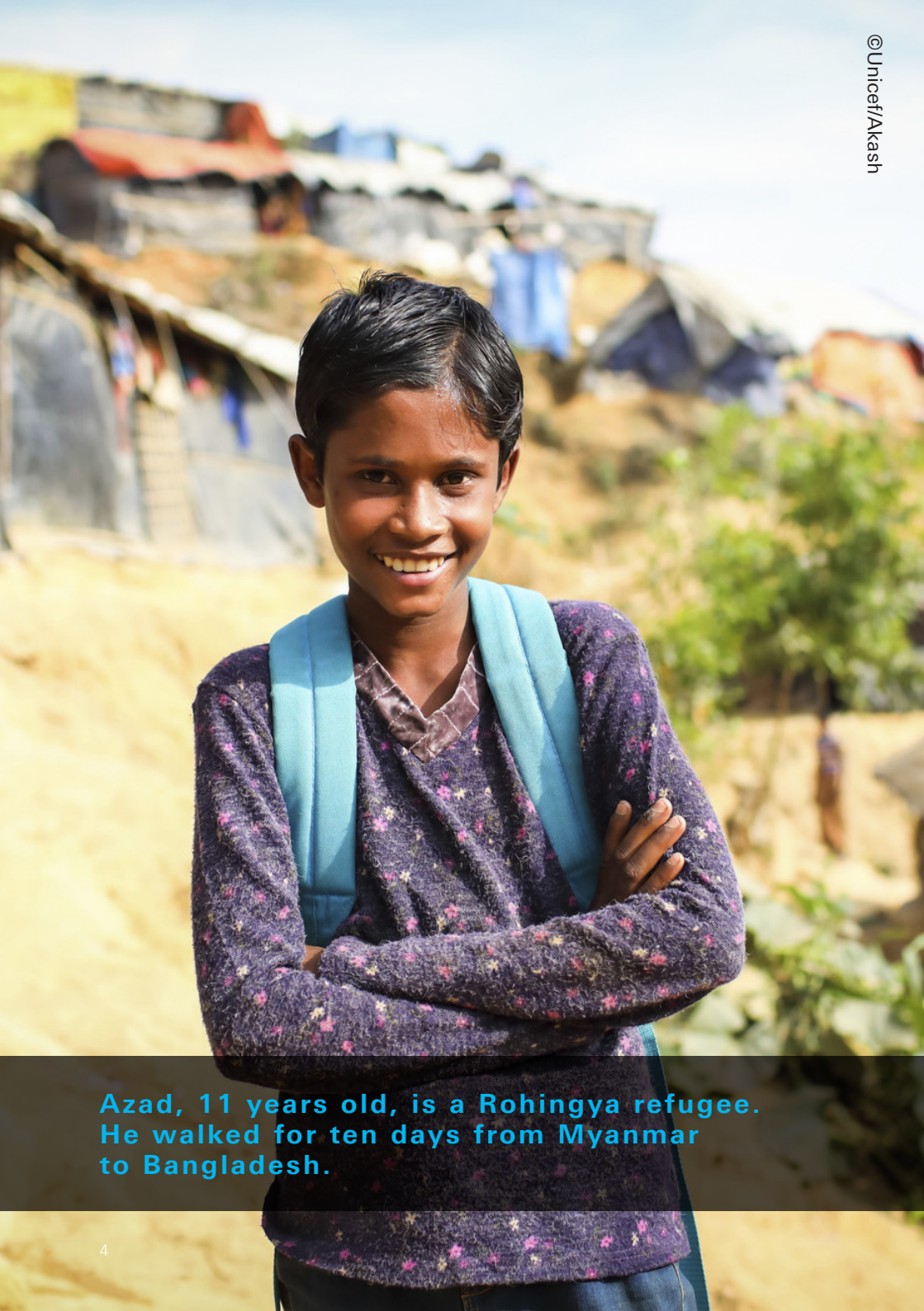

NO CHILD LEFT BEHIND

I am delighted to welcome you to Unicef UK's sixth Halloween Ball. Since 2013, this fantastic event has raised an incredible £4 million for our work protecting children in danger.

Money raised through the Halloween Ball to date has delivered life-changing results for children affected by the ongoing conflict in Syria. Together, we have helped deliver over 51 million vaccines to children in Syria and neighbouring countries. We've helped almost two million children in the region enrol in formal education. And we've provided access to safe drinking water to over 28 million people.

Despite this phenomenal achievement, sadly, millions of children in Syria and around the world still desperately need our help.

While crises such as the war in Syria receive widespread media coverage and strong support from public appeals, Unicef responds to more than 300 crises each year, many of which do not make the headlines. This means we are reliant on readily available funds that allow us to reach the most marginalised and disadvantaged children anywhere in the world – no matter how remote or difficult to access.

MARIYA'S STORY

WINNING THE BATTLE AGAINST POLIO –
UNICEF'S FIGHT FOR CHILD SURVIVAL.

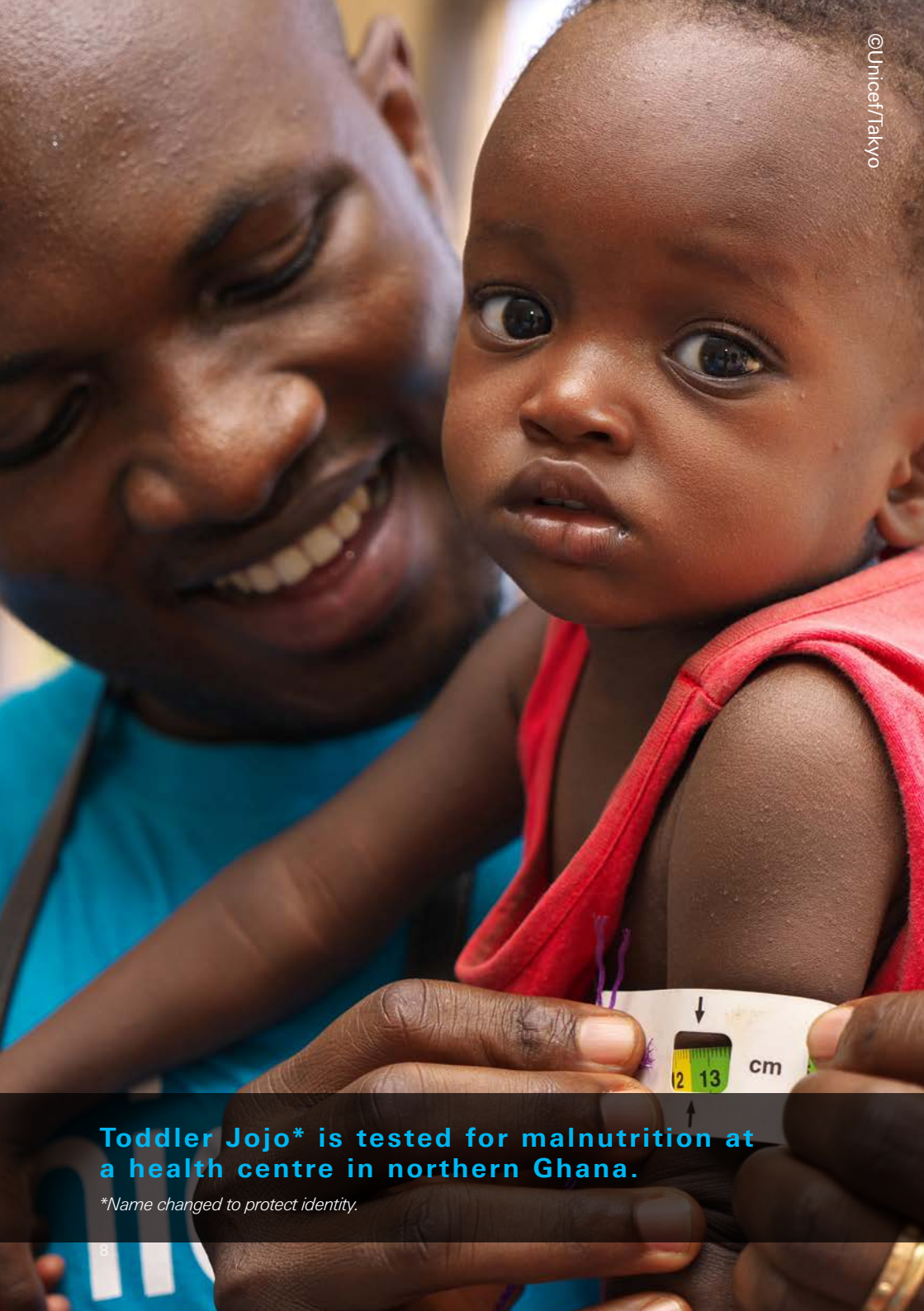
Mariya, aged five, is now protected against polio. She shows the purple ink mark on her little finger, which confirms she has received the vaccine.

Mariya lives in Islamabad, Pakistan. Pakistan is one of only three countries in the world where polio remains endemic, together with Afghanistan and Nigeria. But there is a growing sense of optimism that **polio will be the second disease, after smallpox, to ever be eradicated.**

In 2017, Unicef spent nearly **£4 million on polio eradication efforts** in Afghanistan and Pakistan which allowed us to deliver over 110 million doses of the vaccine. In 2014, there were 334 cases of polio in the region. Just three years later there were 22 – **a 90 percent reduction.**

Tonight, you have the power to help children like Mariya receive the life-saving vaccines they need to stay happy and healthy.

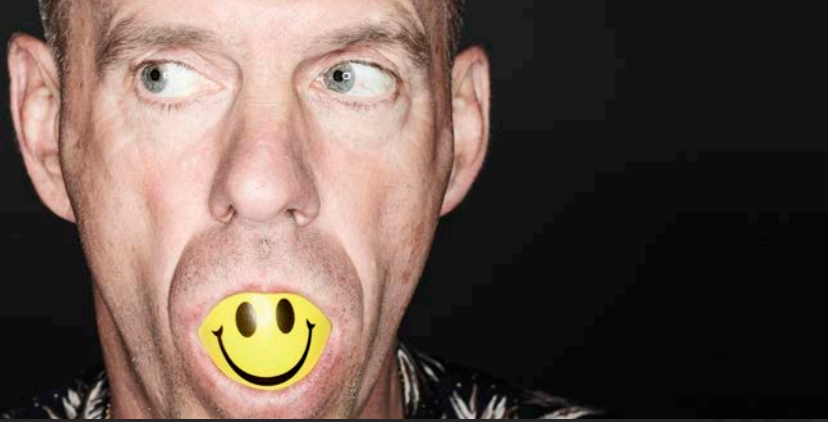

The President of Kosovo, Rita's country of birth, awarded her honorary ambassador for raising awareness of the country and she continues to support Unicef's tremendous efforts to help children in danger around the world.



ON THE ROAD WITH CHARLEY BOORMAN

I first became involved with Unicef while filming *Long Way Round* with Ewan McGregor in 2004, when we travelled to Ukraine, Kazakhstan and Mongolia. Since then, I've seen first-hand Unicef's work for children all over the world. In Uganda, I met Grace, a former child soldier, recruited when she was just eight years old.

"The LRA came to our village. They took me and my brother. I was given as a wife to the commander and had to live in one of his households," Grace said. "Four years after I was abducted, I heard that my brother was dead."

Grace was eventually returned to her family after seven years in captivity. Unicef helps release and rehabilitate child soldiers, providing education and protection services and reuniting children with relatives.

I am honoured to be a Unicef Ambassador. If you ever wonder whether the money you donate makes a difference, I can say that it absolutely does. So please dig deep and give whatever you can to change a child's life today.

CHARLOTTE BOLLAND – VISITING DJIBOUTI WITH UNICEF

My husband, Peter, and I have supported Unicef since 2011. In September we were invited to Djibouti to see their work first-hand.

The day centre for street children was, for me, the most heart-breaking part of the trip. On arrival, seven-year-old Kadra* reached out to hold my hand. Kadra has never been to school and she does not have a Djiboutian birth certificate, even though she was born in Djibouti. This prevents her from accessing basic public services.

Unicef-supported centres offer children living on the streets of Djibouti a lifeline during the day – hot meals, healthcare and lessons. But due to government restrictions, when night falls, the children, who are vulnerable to violence, abuse and exploitation, go back out to their nightmare. Despite this, they are smiling and dreaming of a better future. Kadra is eager to go to school one day and "be like other children".

It was impossible not to think of the children as we went to bed that night. It still is. There are so many stories we could share with you. Against all the odds, these children are full of hope, resilience and determination. But it's not enough. This is all of our problem – something we all should take responsibility for. As a Halloween Ball Committee member, Unicef supporter and mother, I know that we can each transform a child's life.
